Prior core knowledge

Recognise that a good secret is something that will make you feel happy and excited. A bad secret is something that might make you feel worried, uncomfortable or sad.

Recognise who trustworthy—family member over the age of 18, adults in school wearing the school lanyard who are recognisable, police officer, doctor etc.

Understanding that fair means everyone gets what they need, based on opportunity. Unfair is to treat someone unkindly, or to refuse them equal rights

Year 2

Know we need to show respect to people around us and understand that we are equal.

Understand that diversity means we are all different and come from different backgrounds.

Understand how to keep money safe and make positive changes around money.

To know who my trusted adults are and how to seek help if I experience or see bullying happen.

To know how to look after myself and my friends

Recognise how my behaviour affects other people,

Demonstrate ways of being responsible if I see bullying happening.

What is the difference between a fact and an opinion?

An opinion is an idea or something you think about or believe that is not based on a fact. A fact is something that is certain and supported by evidence.

What is a community and what does it feel like to be part of one?
