

# HEARTS Curriculum – Termly Summary



## EYFS (Reception) Autumn term B

### Topic Summary

<b>Autumn 1: Marvellous Me!</b>	<p>Children will be able to talk about themselves, their family, and their school. They will become familiar with their new school and the different children in their new class. Children will learn new rules and expectations. The topic will support Personal, Social and Emotional development where children will be encouraged to build relationships, think about the feelings of other people, form friendships and manage their own needs. This will support progression into key stage 1 where the PSHE curriculum links to listening and expressing views and living in the wider world (rules, expectations and needs). This topic will also support the key stage 1 RE curriculum where children will learn about families and people who care for them.</p> <p>They will explore the changes that occur in Autumn linked to Understanding of the World. They will be able to talk about how the leaves change colour and fall from the trees and the changes in temperature/ weather. This will progress through reception where children will learn about the different season and then into key stage 1, where they will learn about locational knowledge within geography and seasonal changes within science.</p>
<b>Autumn 2: Heroes</b>	<p>Through the topic of heroes', children will think about what a hero is, famous heroes and their own personal heroes, supporting their understanding of difference and diversity. They will be encouraged to develop their communication skills through talking about facts and real-life experiences.</p> <p>The children will use the story of Supertato to think about different food types and healthy eating. This will support progression in PSHE and PE within reception and key stage 1.</p> <p>The children will be encouraged to use a variety of materials including construction, mark making tools and small world to make their own superheroes and add story lines into their play. Towards the end of the term, children will learn about the celebration of Christmas. This will link to RE within reception and key stage 1.</p>
