EYFS (Reception) Summer Term A

Topic Summary

Summer 1: Summer at the seaside

Summer 2: New Adventures

Through the topic of Summer at the seaside, they will be able to talk about the seaside – what is found at the seaside and some features of the landscape. This will build upon pre-school and nursery where they will have explored the beach. This topic will explore what a lighthouse is and why they are needed. They will explore what the role of a lighthouse keeper is. Throughout this half term, the children will learn about what happens at the coronation of a king or queen to support cultural capital and British values. This topic supports the key stage one geography topics where they will explore further landscapes, habitats and animals. It will also support their knowledge within lower key stage 2 DT where they learn about electricity and making a circuit.

The topic of new adventures will support the children to prepare for the next stage of their journey into key stage 1. Through play and activities, children will be encouraged to think about different emotions. They will also participate in circle times to talk about their new teacher, new classroom and be able to ask and answer questions.

The children will learn about summer including how to stay safe in the sunshine and the weather we have in the summer.
